A afirmação de Jenrick tem sido criticada pelo Partido Trabalhista, um ex-procurador-geral conservador e um ex-oficial do exército.

Forças especiais matando terroristas

No {sp}, após listar criminosos estrangeiros que Jenrick alega não terem sido deportados devido às leis europeias de direitos humanos, o ex-ministro da imigração disse: "Nossas forças especiais estão matando onabet aceita cartão de crédito vez de capturar terroristas porque nossos advogados nos dizem que, se forem apanhados, o tribunal europeu vai soltá-los."

Críticas à afirmação de Jenrick

Uma fonte trabalhista pediu a Jenrick que se desculpasse. "A tentativa ridícula de Robert Jenrick de politizar nossas forças especiais mostra o quão longe os conservadores caíram. Ele deveria se desculpar. Nossos homens e mulheres de serviço merecem melhor do que isso."
